WHAT HAPPENS IN THE WORKSHOPS?



For our EYFS sessions we often find an hour long session can be too much for 2-4year olds, so we break down our sessions differently to those in school. The shortest session we offer is two hours, but that can be split into multiple groups or one group depending on what you think would suit your children best.



THE ULTIMATE VAN EXPERIENCE



*****Available between March 1st-September 31st*****

We are the world's ONLY mobile exotics unit! We really do bring the zoo to you in our Van Experience!

The van experience (17+ animals) covering any topic you require. We can park up on fields (as long as not too wet), playgrounds or car parks as required. The space **MUST** be accessible by a large van (7m long just under 3m wide and 3m high) for this session. We **MUST** also have access to a plug socket (we bring our own extension leads as needed).

A minimum of our 6m x 3m gazebo is added onto the back or side of our van which acts as an outdoor classroom. This means we need a total of 13m x 3m space or 7m x 7m) minimum. We can provide up to 30 chairs which will be placed under our gazebo to shade from the sun or shelter from any rain (we have sides to be used if windy/cold).

A minimum of 2 hours- £400 (comes with Curiosity Corner- see page for more details)



1 HOUR SESSION PER GROUP

(Minimum of 2 groups per visit)



Total visit will be 2 hours £350 plus mileage

- 30 mins meeting the animals, learning quick but fun facts about up to 10 animals (either of your choosing or you can leave it up to us)
- 30mins of Curiosity Corner (see Curiosity Corner information for more details)



1 HOUR 30 SESSION PER GROUP

(Minimum of 2 groups per visit)



Total visit will be 2 hours £450 plus mileage

- 45 mins meeting the animals, learning quick but fun facts about up to 10 animals (either of your choosing or you can leave it up to us)
- 45 mins of Curiosity Corner (see Curiosity Corner information for more details)



2 HOUR SESSION PER GROUP

(Minimum of 1 group per visit)



Total visit will be 2 hours £350 plus mileage

- 35 mins meeting the animals, learning lots of fun facts about the first 5 animals (either of your choosing or you can leave it up to us)
- 25 mins of Curiosity Corner split into 2 groups, with one half taking part in one half of the activities and the other group the other half of activities (see Curiosity Corner information for more details)
- 35 mins meeting the animals, learning lots of facts about the last 5 animals
- 25mins of Curiosity Corner (group 1 and 2 now swap over activities)



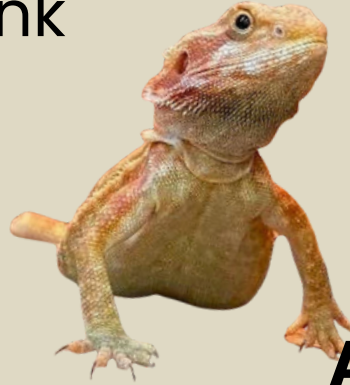

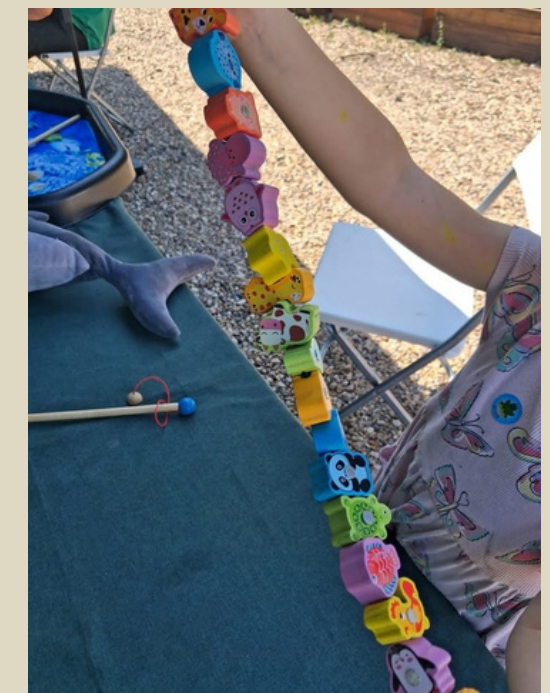
